Charge your devices at the library

Need to charge your smart phone or tablet and forgot your cables at home? No problem! The King Township Public Library (KTPL) will now loan kits to support charging both Android and Apple devices.

KTPL recognizes the need for this service and is offering a “charging kit” for patrons’ convenience, to use while at the library. The kit contains: a portable charger, a charger plug, and the respective cables. The benefit of the portable kits is that you can keep your devices with you while they re-charge. The library has plenty of workspace and available outlets for you to plug into.

“Frontline staff were reporting an increase in the number of patrons asking if they could borrow cables in order to charge their personal-hand-held devices while visiting the library,” said Rona O’Banion, KTPL’s Chief Executive Officer. “Staff immediately turned their attention to this matter, and developed an in-house solution that would address the gap and supply the necessary equipment that was responsive to the needs of patrons.”
